Participation Fee

An annual athletic participation fee of \$25.00 will be charged for the 2020-2021 school year. If a family has more than one child participating, the following rate schedule will apply:

- \$25.00 for the first child
- \$15.00 for the second child
- \$10.00 for each additional child

Parent and Athlete Meetings

The Waynesville Athletic Department will conduct a meeting virtually for student-athletes who plan to participate in a fall, winter, and/or spring sport for the 2020-2021 school year. All 7th grade, 9th grade student athletes are required to view the meeting. All other student-athletes who have not attended a sports parent/athlete meeting in the past will also be required to attend. Here is the link for the mandatory meeting:

You can turn in high school physicals into Athletic Office at any time and the middle school physicals to the nurse at the middle school anytime. **One parent/guardian MUST watch this meeting WITH their son or daughter.** A student will not be allowed to play in a game, match, or contest if they do not view the meeting and fill out the registration. The focus of the meeting concerns eligibility, sportsmanship, the student-athlete code of conduct, and parent-coach communication.

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Academics

- * You must have earned, the preceding semester of attendance, a minimum of 3.00 units of credit or have earned credit in 80% of the maximum allowable classes in which any student can be enrolled in the semester, whichever is greater, at your school.
- * For your current semester, you must be enrolled in and regularly attending courses that offer 3.0 units of credit or 80% of the maximum allowable credits which may be earned, whichever is greater, for your school.
- * Waynesville has a no F Policy. **HS students will not be eligible if they fail a course the previous semester.** Credits earned or completed after the close of the semester will not fulfill this requirement. **Middle school eligibility will be determined using 9-week progress reports.**
- * **Do not drop courses without first consulting with your school principal or athletic administrator to determine whether it will affect your eligibility.**

Any student-athlete wishing to participate in activities or athletics must be enrolled in seated classes prior to the start of the season unless that student is a new transfer into the district. All transfer students are subject to Missouri State High School Activities Association policies and must be first cleared through MSHSAA to compete.



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
